S-3 PERIODIC REPORT

1. Our Front Lines: See Overlay.
2. Location of Troops: See Overlay.
3. Information on Adjacent Units: Unit on Left : 7th Armd Div.
Unit on Right: 39th Inf.
4. Weather : Clear, cool.
Visibility: 5 miles.
5. Our Operations for the Period:
 - a- 1st Bn: Continued the attack at 0800 hours, moved to north to high ground, met light resistance, reached intermediate objective at 1500 hours, continued to capture the town of DORHEIM where forward movement ceased.
 - b. 2d Bn: Attacked at 0800 hours in its zone, made rapid advances and had captured the towns of ALTEWILPE and OBER HENNEBORN by 1830 hours where forward movement ceased, contacted adjacent units on right and left.
 - c. 3d Bn: Moved in regimental reserve from south of HÖRPFELD to a position in rear of 1st Bn, attacked through that Bn at 1400 hours, made rapid advances to capture OBER RARBACH and KIRCHRARBACH where it stopped for the night.
 - d. Cn Co: Continued normal support, displaced to OBER RARBACH.
 - e. AT Co: Continued normal support.
6. Combat Efficiency: Excellent.
Casualties : 13.
Prisoners : 165.
7. Results of Our Operations:
 - a. The attack was continued and 6 kilometers of ground was gained.
 - b. Contact was maintained with adjacent units throughout the period.
